- Leave a message & they will call you back within 24 hours.
- \$2 each way, cash only, exact change, paid to the driver
- Rides available 8:30 a.m. 3 p.m., Monday Friday, in the county only
- Curb to curb service with bus coming to your driveway for pick-up
- Riders must be able to get to the bus and into their destination themselves.
- You should be ready at the door at the assigned time.

Ride-Share (Uber or Lyft), arranged by nonprofit Common Courtesy

- To participate you will need a smartphone, a credit card and the ability to be ready at the door at the assigned time.
- Ride-share cars will not wait for you, nor can they help you to get back and forth to the car.
- You must fill out an application and pay a \$15 registration fee.
- Rides are \$2 each way, charged to a credit card kept on file.
- Rides are available 7:30 a.m. until 5 p.m.
- Once registered, you will hear from Common Courtesy within 48 hours with further instructions.
